(1) Documents and other Things You Need to Bring to Taiwan

- (2) Brief Introduction to Taiwan and Pingtung
- ◆ Geographical Location Taiwan is located in the Western Pacific to the southeast of Mainland China, with Japan and the Ryukyu Islands to the North, and the Philippines to the South. Pingtung county is located between Kaohsiung county and Bashi channel and known for its agriculture and tourism.
- ♦ Surface Area-Taiwan is about 36,000 square kilometers and Pingtung is about 2776 square kilometers
- ♦ Weather The climate of Taiwan is subtropical. Its summer is hot and humid (~25° C to 35° C). Its winter is short, from December to February, and relatively mild, but the temperature can get down to ~10° C.

- ◆ Religion Taiwan's constitution guarantees religious freedom and this is reflected in the variety of religions found in Taiwan, including: Buddhism, Taoism, Christianity, Catholicism, Islam, etc.

2. Discovering Taiwan/ Pingtung

(1) Location: Taiwan lies on the western edge of the Pacific Ocean in an area known as the "rim of fire". It lies off the southeastern coast of Asia, across the Taiwan Strait from mainland China. To the north is Japan, and to the south is the Philippines. Many airlines fly to Taiwan, making it the perfect travel destination.

(2) Climate: Taiwan enjoys warm weather all year round. Weather conditions fluctuate during spring and winter, while in summer and autumn the weather is relatively stable. Taiwan is extremely suitable for traveling, as the annual average temperature is a comfortable 22 degrees Celsius (71.6 Fahrenheit) with the lowest temperatures on the lowlands generally ranging from 12 to 17 degrees Celsius (54-63 Fahrenheit). Except for a few mountain areas where some traces of snow can be found during winter, one rarely sees snow in Taiwan. During rainy season (March to May), continuously drizzling rain will sometimes fall on Taiwan.

1. Transportation

NPTU is divided into Minsheng (<u>民生)</u> Campus, Linsen (<u>林森</u>) Campus and Pingshang (<u>屏商</u>) Campus, which both are located in Pingtung City.




➢ About Pbike

The mass transportation of Pingtung City is mainly by means of Taiwan Railway and Highway Passenger Bus to Pingtung station. However, it is not the center of the majority of trips around the city. Therefore, to expand the public transportation services, the Pingtung City government had planned to adjust the routes of the city bus and combine them with the public bike rental system, providing railway and highway bus as the main way, city bus as the secondary way, and bike along with pedestrian as the final way of a public transit network service.

In view of this, in order to use bikes as the "last mile" transportation mode, we plan to build Pingting City bike rental system, combined with other transfer transportations such as Taiwan Railway and Highway Passenger Bus, with different electronic tickets or credit cards. Besides satisfying daily transportation needs of Pingtung citizens, we also make all the efforts to turn bikes into a new tourist transportation when visiting Pingtung so as to make Pingtung a lower carbon city.

2. Accommodation

(1.) Dormitory

Our dormitory provides students with over 3,700 beds. These places have quite and beautiful environment, comfortable and safe. Our dorms ask the students to manage themselves, and they can get in the dorm with their own cards; besides, we also have 24 hours security service. There are cafeterias and student canteen in both males and females' dormitories, enable our students to have meals and buy what they need in the dorms. We also have cable televisions, community rooms, rooms for table tennis, studying, and discussions, and the vender machines, bath, drinking fountains as well. There are charged washing machines and tumble dryers on every floor of the dorms, and air conditioners on nearly every store, to make sure that our students can living and learning in a comfortable environment, that we can



change our students into qualified people of all aspects with the warm and harmonious living environment.



There are coin-operated washing machines, dryers, and public phones on floors. There is a public common room, a study room, an art room, and a table tennis room on the first floor of dormitory, for sake of leisure exercises for students. Other facilities include restaurants and a bookstore.



Our school is in Pingtung City, near the railway station (the distance from the station to our school is about 3 kilometers). Transportation is highly convenient. There are regular and frequent bus services between the school and the bus station (Scooters and bicycles are commonly preferable for students at NPTU).

- 4. All students living in the dorm must obey the following rules; whoever violates any of these rules will be subject to penalties stipulated by NPTU regulations.
 - ➤ Visiting hours: Weekdays 09:00~ 12:00 and 14:00~17:00; The dorms are not open to visitors on weekends and national holidays. Visitors must go to the Service Center on the first floor and leave their ID card there when registering. Visitors are prohibited from entering individual dorm rooms and are only permitted to use the lounge.
 - ➤ Keeping pets of any kind, including dogs, cats, rabbits, birds, mice, snakes, etc., inside dorm rooms is strictly prohibited.
 - ➤ Please take good care of the public facilities and lounge. Visitors caught vandalizing or damaging any public facilities will be required to pay for any necessary repairs.

➤ The following behaviors are not allowed in the dorm rooms:

- 1. Storing personal items in public areas of the dormitory (i.e., areas outside of the student dorm rooms).
- 2. Drying clothes in areas not designated for clothes drying.
- 3. Painting or carving the walls.
- 4. Smoking, drinking, or gambling.
- 5. Cooking.
- 6. Other behaviors in violation of public health, peacefulness, and safety or than damage or endanger the environment.
- ➤ Manufacturing, transporting, selling, or hiding any dangerous objects or drugs, including fuel, arsenic, thallium, MDMA/ecstasy, amphetamines, etc., are strictly prohibited.
- ➤ The master lights of the dormitory building will automatically shut off from 12:00 am (midnight) to 06:00 in the morning. Only desk lamps and electrical outlets on the table will be available during these hours.
- ➤ The use of electric appliances and power strips without permission is strictly prohibited. Only hair dryers, radios, electric insect zappers, and computers are permitted to be plugged in to wall outlets.
- ➤ The voltage of the air conditioner outlets is 220V. Do not plug any other electrical device or those outlets or the devices could burn out.
- ➤ Posters, announcements, and circulars can only be put on the specified bulletin boards by permission. Putting them into the mailboxes is prohibited.
- ➤ Bicycles and motorcycles should be parked in designated student parking lots. Do not park bicycles and motorcycles around the dormitory or in dorm rooms.

1. About NPTU

National Pingtung University (NPTU) is located in Pingtung County, which seat of the southernmost of Taiwan's 19 counties. 

2. Healthcare and Insurance

(1) Medical Check

All freshmen should participate in the physical examination program and the examination will be conducted at the beginning of each new semester. If the medical exam has already been conducted abroad, a copy of the medical exam report needs to be submitted to the health center.

NPTU physical examinations check post:

NPTU will conduct physical examinations for students in the first week of the Fall semester (in September) in the school gym.

(2) Health Insurance

Student Accident Insurance (Optional)

Student insurance costs NT\$500 per month. Once covered under the plan, you may receive compensation if you are hospitalized, use outpatient services, or undergo an operation in the event of illness or accidental injury. Compensation must be claimed within two years of the accident or illness. To claim compensation, please go to Student Assistance Division.

National Health Insurance (NHI)

- Due to the regulation of NHI, only those who have already stayed in Taiwan for more than 6 months are eligible to join the NHI plan.
- Benefits of NHI:

You will be issued a Student NHI IC Card after you join the program. Your NHI IC card, along with Alien Resident Certificate, will allow you to seek covered medical services from NHI-affiliated hospitals and clinics. To avoid wasting of medical resources, you are responsible for the medical facility registration fee as well as other supplementary fees.
